## LAC SKI WEEK TO STEAMBOAT SPRINGS LAURA PREISS

Hi Skiers!! Come to Steamboat with LA Council. It is time to start scheduling your 2023-24 ski season. LAC is going with FWSA to Steamboat Springs, Colorado January 27 to February 3, 2024.

Steamboat Springs is a complete mountain range: Mount Werner, Sunshine Peak, Storm Peak, Thunderhead Peak, Pioneer Ridge, and Christie Peak. It has a 15-year average snow fall of 338 inches. Steamboat has a 36,619 skiers per hour uphill capacity utilizing their 8-passenger gondola, high speed 6 pack, 5 high speed quads, 6 triple and 2 double chairs.

Steamboat Springs is located on 2,939 acres, with a base elevation of 6,900 feet and a summit elevation of 10,568 feet. Steamboat's vertical rise is 3,668 with 165 trails including a gladed tree area. The mountain is 14% Beginner, 42% intermediate, a 44% advanced.

I can help you with putting together the best ski package for you.

1. There are two payment options for trip payments – credit card or check.

- 2. The trip includes 7 nights lodging at either a Hotel or a Ski in/Ski out condo with a kitchen.
- 3. If you have not yet purchased your IKON pass, you will be able to get a trip discount when you buy the IKON pass from SportsAmerica.
- 4. If you are not planning to purchase an IKON or EPIC pass this year, the trip package can include lift tickets for 1 day or 6 days. Adult and senior pricing is available.
- 5. Air into the local Hayden airport and ground transportation to your lodging can also be added to the package.
- 6. The LA Council trip will also include a Welcome Party, a Banquet Dinner and Dance, and Council Dinner Party.
- 7. You can challenge yourself on a GS Race and a Council Challenge Race if you enjoy running gaits.
