Beach Cities Ski Club

Our annual Clambake camping weekend also allows other ski club members to attend, everyone gets the same price. We also print the club's name on the back of the t-shirt when there are 5 or more members attending that year.

Our local summer BBQ's and Pray For Snow Party have a member and non-member price, there is no limit to how many events a non-member can attend. Happy Hours are free to everyone.

Century City Ski Club

Yes we offer other club members the same price for Mammoth trips. One trip at the rate preferred.

For other trips, especially the out of state trips, we require them to join.

Kronenstadt Ski Club

We welcome any member of another LA Council club to travel with us for one or all five, of our five day midweek trips for the \$25 returning member rate. Each trip only has 8 spots so they fill up. But if we don't have 8, we charge a little more and can go with 5 for a few dollars more. (all drive-up trips.) As there is paperwork involved, they do require the above noted fee.

We charge \$40 for new members and \$25 for returning members. They should send me an email requesting a membership application and a trip application. Five days lodging in an 8 person 4 bedroom condo is only \$350. Includes one dinner and 5 breakfasts. We try to carpool up.

Edelweiss Ski Club

We welcome members of other ski clubs to come on our trips, regardless of whether they are members of other clubs. If they haven't paid our membership fee (\$55 for individual, \$75 for couple), they will have to pay non-member price for a trip. If you wish to attend more than one trip, it is better for you to pay the membership fee to get the member price for the trips. 2024 trip prices are: \$340 member, \$380 nonmember.

Usually, we have extra room on our bus and we welcome timely referrals from other clubs.


